



Mazor, Sanyati to move to JSE main board

Aluminium and steel fabricator Mazor Group and construction firm Sanyati would from Friday step up to the JSE's main board, from their current AltX listing, the local bourse said on Thursday.

This came after a request from both companies.

Mazor debuted on the exchange for smaller companies in November last year, while Sanyati listed in June 2006.

Mazor's aluminium division makes doors, windows, shopfronts, and balustrades, while its steel unit designs, supplies and installs steel structural frames for shopping centres, warehouses, buildings, bridges and architectural work.

The firm closed on Wednesday at R2,95 a share, down from its 12-month high of R4,50 a share.

Sanyati is a black empowered civil engineering and construction company, which undertakes work for government and private clients.

The company closed on Wednesday at R1,45 a share, slightly above its 12-month low of R1,40 a share.
